Our Mission

The Represent Foundation aims to increase access to higher education for students from Malawi. We do this through a combination of mentoring, advocacy, and financial support. We believe that representation from diverse backgrounds enriches the college experience for all students.

Progress

Fundraising and Disbursement

We raised a total of \$6,696.84 in 2023.

- \$6,000 Cambridge Charitable Foundation Grant
- \$376.84 through sales of *Lucky: An African Student, An American Dream, and a Long Bike Ride.* (Half the proceeds of each sale, anywhere from \$1.71 to \$7.50, go to the Foundation.)
- \$320 through matching donations from sales of *Lucky* by Kimberley Ladue

We disbursed **\$873.34** to **one student** for two semesters of tuition at the Malawi University of Science and Technology, as well as a stationary stipend.

Milestones

Received our first major grant.

- Established a publicly available scholarship application on our website.
- Established Facebook, Twitter, and LinkedIn profiles.
- Decided as a Board to limit funding to students in degree programs at public universities, pay universities directly, and offer a stationary stipend but not cover all expenses.

Outcomes


Through our financial outreach, we helped one student attend his first year of university. We also recruited a second student who will start university in 2023. Through sales of Lucky, we got our message out to 55 people. We had 294 unique visitors to our website, for a total of 329 visits and 583 pageviews.
